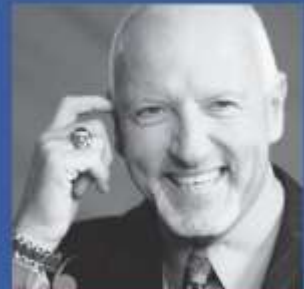

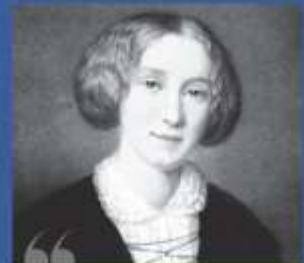

Persistence vs Stubbornness!

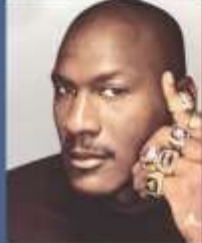
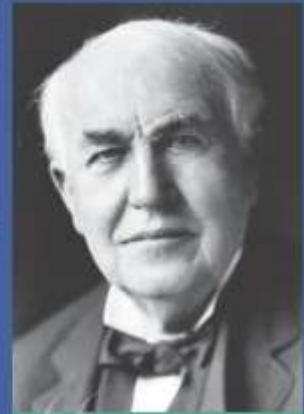
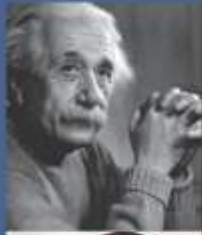
■ What creates Unity?
